The Workshop Meeting of the Bedford Borough Council was held on the above date. The following Council Members were in attendance, Tim Weaverling, Jeff Rinscheid, Bill Blackburn, and Kenny Fetterman. Borough Manager Barbara Diehl and Borough Secretary Beverly Geller were also in attendance.

Council Members Sharon Turkovich and John Cessna were absent along with Mayor William Leibfreid, Public Services Director Brad Foor, Police Chief Craig Bowman, Solicitor Dean Crabtree and Timothy Cooper, P.E. of Stiffler, McGraw & Assoc., Inc.

Manager Diehl shared that a dividend check was received from EMC Insurance Company in the amount of \$32,439.18. The dividend was made possible due to our membership in PSAB and our participation in the Safety Group Insurance Program through EMC for good loss experience. The amount was deposited with \$19,787.89 deposited in Borough General Fund 01 and \$12,651.29 in Borough Sewer Fund 08.

Councilman Patrick Neff joined the meeting at 3:12 p.m.

Motion was made by Councilman Blackburn, seconded by Councilman Rinscheid, to approve Requisition #2-2020 for the Borough Building Renovation Project in the amount of \$66,579.85. Motion was carried by unanimous vote (5-0).

Manager Diehl invited Council Members to tour the progress on interior demolition in the Borough Building and the newly completed Fire Department building following adjournment.
